

Nine Leading Indicators of SIG

The nine (9) leading indicators listed below will be used to hold schools receiving SIG funds accountable.

1. Number of minutes within the school year;
2. Student participation rate on State assessments in reading/language arts and in mathematics, by student subgroup;
3. Dropout rate;
4. Student attendance rate;
5. Number and percentage of students completing advanced coursework (e.g., AP/IB), early college high schools, or dual enrollment courses;
6. Discipline incidents;
7. Truants;
8. Distribution of teachers by performance level on an LEA's teacher evaluation system, and
9. Teacher attendance rate.
